Sounding Syllables

The sound of syllables has an effect on the person whose name is being said out loud.

It also affects any person who verbalizes or hears that name.



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Sounding Syllables

“Anne” has a very different meaning than “Suzanne”.

The difference is not only the spelling but the sound of one syllable vs. two.
